

## CAMINO UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT EDUCATION PROTECTION ACCOUNT

The Education Protection Account (EPA) provides local educational agencies (LEAs) with general purpose state aid funding pursuant to Proposition 30, the Schools and Local Public Safety Protection Act of 2012, approved by the voters on November 6, 2012. The EPA funding is a component of an LEA's total revenue limit or charter school general purpose entitlement. **Proposition 55** takes effect January 1, 2018 and the income taxes generated will be distributed to each LEAs' EPA. The statutory reporting requirements of Proposition 30 mentioned above carry forward under Proposition 55.

Proposition 30 provides that all K-14 local agencies have the sole authority to determine how the funds received from the EPA are spent, but with the following provisions:

The new revenues generated from Proposition 30 are deposited into a newly created state account called the Education Protection Account (EPA). Proposition 30 requires that the use of EPA funds be determined by the governing board at an open public meeting

Proposition 30 specifies that LEAs may not use EPA funds for salaries or benefits of administrators or any other administrative costs.

Each year, the local agency must publish on its website an accounting of how much money was received from the EPA and how the funds were expended.

EPA funds are planned to be spent in 2017/2018 as follows:
